I served as pastor of a church in Delaware from 1988-96, which was not too far from Baltimore, MD. One Friday night I took my three sons to see the Orioles play baseball. The game went extra innings and, to tell you the truth, I can't even remember who won. When the game concluded (close to 11:00 p.m.) my sons and I waited at a certain gate to get autographs from the Orioles players as they went home. Of course, that would mean after they showered, received treatment if necessary, dressed, perhaps talked with the media in the dressing room, and then went home. Finally, some of the players started to come our way and we were able to get a few autographs. But the one player that my sons and I wanted to see the most was Cal Ripken. So we waited, and waited, and waited. I figured, it's Friday night and I'm off the next day so I'm going to wait as long as it takes to secure this prized autograph. Finally, at 2:00 a.m., Cal Ripken emerged from the dressing room and walked our way. By that time many of the autograph seekers had left for home, which was better for the small group that remained. Well, we were able to get a number of things autographed by Cal Ripken including his baseball cards and a baseball cap. I still have the baseball card he signed for me, but I doubt if my sons still have their signed memorabilia from that special evening. As I reflect back on that night and the eager expectancy my sons and I felt as we waited for superstar Cal Ripken to appear, I am reminded that Jesus Christ will return one day and Christians are to be watching for His glorious return! As we await the coming of Christ, there is much work to be done for the kingdom and many people who need to hear the gospel. While Paul was confined to a Roman prison he penned the letter to the Philippians. He writes, "Now I want you to know, brethren, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the gospel...." (Phil. 1:12) Although Paul was imprisoned, the gospel of Jesus Christ was not. In fact, as a result of his imprisonment, the gospel advanced throughout the entire praetorian guard and to others as well (v.13). The praetorian guard consisted of 10,000 hand-picked soldiers stationed in Rome to guard the emperor. Also other Christians, encouraged by the fortitude of Paul the prisoner, displayed courage in speaking the Word of God without fear (v.14). We too, as followers of Christ, must exemplify bravery and compassion in sharing the good news of Jesus Christ with those around us. Our circumstances may not always be "ideal" but we must possess a commitment to evangelism that is fueled by faith and love, which overcomes fear. To this end, I want to invite everyone to our upcoming MBA Spring Evangelism Conference on Thursday, April 19, to be held at Southside Baptist Church (mark your calendar!). We have two powerful preachers in Dr. Danny Lovett and Dr. Joel Carwile coming to share God's Word with us on this crucial topic.
